4 Handheld Radios, 2 Pagers			Sitting in chargers in squad lounge
Gas and oil			Gas at 3/4 full or higher
Warning lights			Check warning lights, head lights, brake lights, scene lights, turn signals
Ambulance Radios			Operational and scanning (request radio check if in doubt)
Infection control supplies			S, M, L, XL gloves, face shields
Vehicle Oxygen			Note tank PSI (change at 500)
Portable Oxygen			Note tank PSI (change at 200)
Airway supplies			Oral airway kit, pulse oximeter functional
Airway kit			Adult ETT, EGTA
Oxygen masks			Nasal cannulas, simple masks, non-rebreathers, 2 bag-valve masks
Vehicle suction			Catheter and tubing present, spare suction supplies present
Portable suction			Unit is charging, catheter and tubing present, kit has gloves and mask
BP cuff, Stethoscope			2 stethoscopes, 2 intact cuffs with working valves
Sharps not overflowing			Transport to FVIEW at 2/3rds full
Linen, Blankets, shears, penlight			Properly stocked
Jump kit			Properly stocked
Pediatric kit			Pediatric ETT, child/infant BVM's
IV kit			Properly stocked (or lock is in place)
Epipens, Charcoal, Glucose			Check Epipen clarity, expiration dates, tamper seals
Defibrillator			2 defib pads, tape, razor, washcloth, leads stored neatly
MAST anti-shock garment			Intact and stored neatly
Backboarding supply bag			4 quick-clips, 2 roller buckles, full set of collars
Backboards, scoop stretcher			Strapped securely, scoop is not touching O ₂
Stairchair, KED, shortboard			Strapped securely
